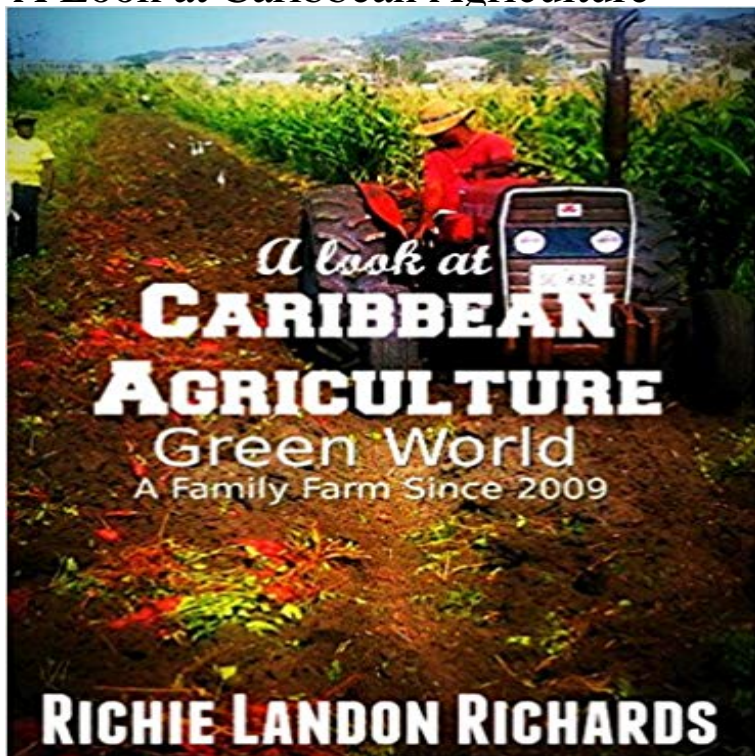


A Look at Caribbean Agriculture
